**History of Effingham County
United Methodist
Camp Meeting**

Since the year 1790, folks have gathered at the Effingham County Campground, presently located on Business Highway 21, one mile south of the center of Springfield, for six days of meetings, preaching, singing and fellowship.

Several local families have "tents" where they live during the meeting. There is a "tent" owned by the campground for the housing of children and youth. A fine, well rounded program is planned each year for them.

The present tabernacle is new in comparison to the years of history of the camp meeting. The tabernacle was originally located in the center of Springfield, but the coming of the railroad necessitated its relocation. Mr. Brinson, of the Brinson Railroad, negotiated with the Methodists to move the campground to its present location. In the move, he gave them sixteen acres of land for ten acres that the campground then covered and built the "new" tabernacle, sometime between 1905 and 1910.

The tabernacle, constructed of hand-hewn pine is the center of activities. On Sunday, some United Methodist churches in the county call off services in their own churches, and the tabernacle becomes the "church house" for that day.
